### **Teach English in a preschool in Japan**

We are seeking volunteers to teach English at Ohana English Preschools (OEP) in Yokohama, Japan. Volunteer must be 50 years+, love working with children and commit to a three month stay. The school provides a condo and small stipend.

The exposure to American seniors as volunteers at the preschool level is a new concept in Japan. Parents are looking for high quality education for their children and they want an international experience. The elder volunteers in the International Child Care program (ICC) will have conversations with the children to help them to understand new English words and encourage them to use language to express themselves. The elder teachers will read to the children, sing songs, do fitness activities and talk with them during play and help them to put their ideas into words.

ten day study tours are being designed to help you incorporate intergenerational perspectives and activities in your discipline (early childhood, elementary and high school education, elder care giving, gerontology, sociology, arts education). Intergenerational activities are those that are intentional in bringing children, youth and older adults together to support each other. Successful examples have included programs where older adults tutor and mentor the young. Shared sites are those settings that co-locate child care and elder care facilities. Many other examples of integrating young and old abound throughout the world and will be made available for site visits.
